DIRECTIONS TO BRADWALL HALL STABLES

From the A50 (i.e., from the East of Sandbach)

If Northbound, turn left, if Southbound, turn right on to A534 towards Sandbach at Arclid traffic lights situated at A50/A534 crossroads. After about one mile you will cross the M6 after which (just after a Texaco Station) turn right at bollards SP. Bradwell 3 miles and after that turn right on to Offley Road. At the mini roundabout at the end of Offley Road, turn right in to Bradwall Road. Go past Sandbach Rugby Club and the end of Pillar Box Lane and the drive to Bradwall Hall Stables is on the left, on a left hand bend adjacent to Bradwall Village Hall.

From the M6, junction 17 – Turn towards Sandbach on the A534 and follow as above.

From the West of Sandbach

You will approach either from the A533 Middlewich Road, the A534 Sandbach Bypass or Crewe Road through Wheelock. In each case go to the roundabout (just below Waitrose and Homebase) at the junction of the A533 and A534 and go along the A534 to the first traffic lights and turn left up the High Street (passing the Church on your right) towards the Town Centre.

At the mini roundabout at the end of the High Street turn left to the next roundabout (a large one with flowers) and take the third exit which leads directly (over one mini roundabout) to Bradwall Road and past Sandbach Rugby Club and then as above.
